

Response to Active Shooter Level II

Krav Maga Institute Integrated Training Division

Response to Active Shooter - Level II is an intermediate-level course teaching a multidimensional response to an act of mass violence. Following a systematic progression of increasing stress and complexity, students will learn techniques and problem-solving strategies to evade, barricade, and engage an active shooter and to treat life-threatening wounds to bystanders and themselves.

Course Topics:

- ◆ Nature of mass violence
- ◆ Decision making protocols for individuals and teams
- ◆ Anti-shooter combatives and weapon disarms
- ◆ Improvised weapon identification and usage
- ◆ Flashlight techniques for impact, distraction, and low-light patient care
- ◆ Patient triage techniques for a mass casualty incident
- ◆ Emergency patient movement
- ◆ Trauma management and first aid when partially disabled or injured

Prerequisites:

- ◆ Training: None required, Response to Active Shooter Level I preferred.
- ◆ Physical: Sense of humor and an ability to stand, knee, and crawl.

Equipment Needed:

- ◆ Clothing: Comfortable clothing for light athletic activity
- ◆ Footwear: Clean, athletic shoes
- ◆ Water bottle and light snacks (*optional*)
- ◆ EDC Flashlight (*optional*)
- ◆ Clothing and footwear for outdoor field exercise

The course will conclude with an outdoor field portion that will include stage moulage. While the artificial blood washes out well, there is the possibility of staining. Participants will have time and facilities to change prior to the final outdoor section.
