Digital Learning Karate Camp

Statements of Understanding

I understand the Virginia Martial Arts Center is a Martial Arts Training School, not a daycare or an academic school. Students are free to come and go at the direction of their parents. Students participating in the Virginia Martial Arts Center Digital Learning Karate Camp (hereinafter referred to as “the Camp”) will be provided time, space, and internet access to complete self-paced school assignments and will participate in scheduled physical activities and Martial Arts classes.

I understand that the Camp is scheduled around the City of Chesapeake School schedule and may be subject to change as the City of Chesapeake Public Schools schedule changes. Camp registration is available as a nine weeks program.

I understand that the Camp is a Martial Arts based program and students participating in the Camp will be required to participate in Martial Arts and Fitness related activities/games during scheduled recess times.

I understand that Virginia Martial Arts Center staff WILL NOT provide tutoring or assist with academic class work assignments/lessons (except to answer basic questions for clarification or understanding) – our staff is here to direct the physical fitness/Martial Arts aspects of our program and to moderate and ensure internet access during academic study time blocks.

I understand that once my child is registered in the program, my tuition is due regardless of my attendance until formally canceled via the Camp cancellation policies. If the City of Chesapeake Public Schools system changes its schedule, Virginia Martial Arts Center will adjust its schedule as necessary to meet the needs of the registered students.

I understand that the Camp cannot provide any meals for its participant and that I must provide all meals for my child. Pre-packaged snacks and drinks may be purchased by participants at the snack bar.

I understand that there is no transportation provided for any portion of the Camp program. I must drop off and pick up my child from the facility as scheduled in the Camp information.

I understand that the Camp does not provide any Electronic devices for student use. All electronics must be provided by the participant and that all responsibility for care/upkeep/maintenance is the sole responsibility of the device owner. The Camp and its staff are NOT RESPONSIBLE for lost, damaged, or misplaced property of any kind. Participants must take all property home daily as the Camp does not provide secure storage for personal belongings.

I understand that internet access will be provided through the school WIFI system if needed, however, the school is not responsible for monitoring which sites each student accesses on their device. Additionally, if a student is using their own internet access system (phone as a hotspot or a jetpack), the school will not be able to control which sites are accessed by the student. While the school system will have basic parental controls installed as a precaution, there is no way to guarantee that a student will not intentionally or inadvertently access an inappropriate site. If any student is discovered to be accessing inappropriate material while on campus, their internet access will immediately be suspended and a parent will be notified. Virginia Martial Arts Center will not tolerate the viewing or sharing of inappropriate material in our program.
