What does it take to become an instructor at Hilliard Taekwondo Academy?

- Perseverance** - it takes a minimum of 3 years of training and passing increasing challenging belt rank testings to earn that first black belt before a student may apply to participate in the instructor training program
- Character** - a student must be a role model within their classes and live the taekwondo values of courtesy, integrity, perseverance, self-control and indomitable spirit to be accepted into the instructor training program
- Dedication** - instructors commit to participating in training to improve their leadership skills and to move up through the instructor ranks as well as continuing the training necessary to earn their next belt rank
