FAQ’s

THEATER/GUEST Information:

- Tickets Purchased Listing, will be at the door
- Tickets may be purchased online or at the door for \$15; Concessions will be available for purchase prior to the show, and may only be consumed in the Lobby or Courtyard.
- ALL Seating is GENERAL ADMISSION. Ushers will be available for anyone with special needs or who requires assistance.
- **The Synetic Theater has implemented additional COVID-19 Safety Protocols for In-Person Performances which we are required to follow:**
 - *All **guests** over the age of 12 will provide proof of vaccination or a negative PCR test along with their I.D. prior to entry*
 - *(I.D.s not required for minors accompanied by an adult) Children under 12 are not required to provide proof of vaccination or a negative test*
 - Proof of Vaccination Options
 - *Physical copy + ID with same name
 - *Digital copy + ID with same name
 - *QR code app + validated birthdate
 - PCR Test Specifications
 - *Negative PCR test result copy dated 72 hours ago or less + ID with same name
- **Masks are required at all times, except when consuming beverages or snacks**
- ***All staff and volunteers are fully vaccinated and will be masked at all times.***
- The Synetic Theater has increased the number of cleanings in the theater and offer multiple hand sanitizing stations throughout the lobby
- Please NO food or drink in the theater
- The Synetic Theater regularly seats 325, we are using only two-thirds of this space to provide social distancing between parties. Please be courteous. There are NO “bad seats” in the theater

DANCER Information:

- Please be sure that your child's name is on **EACH article of their attire (including each shoe)**, and that they have a dance bag/tote to carry their items.
- Dancers arrive at the theater with appropriate warm-up clothing, as we do at our studio. Warm-up attire may be a dress, or tops *and* bottoms over dance clothing. As there will be a break between the rehearsal and show, warm ups are important for the dancers comfort.
- Dancers should have the following items with them backstage:
 - hairspray and/or gel
 - brush
 - hair pins
 - hair nets
 - sewing kit (for those on pointe)
 - *their own make-up supplies* (for those with make-up requirement).
 - An additional pair of tights (for those with tights, it is never a bad idea)
 - personal costume items (undergarments, shoes, etc.)
 - extra mask(s)
- Dancers who need assistance to make stage ready hair will have it from Studio Staff backstage
- Dancers will be in their assigned dressing area when not on stage for rehearsal or performance
- Studio Cooperative Volunteers will be identified by a Volunteer Nametag/Badge
- Studio Cooperative Personnel and Volunteers will be available to assist all dancers in the backstage areas
- For Covid-19 Safety and Security Reasons: NO additional parents or family will be allowed backstage
- Dancers will be returned to their families IMMEDIATELY AFTER the performance from the front of the stage. Please have at least one family member remain in the theater seating to collect your dancer.

COSTUME & CALL INFO:

Primary Ballet Students (*Frogs/Mice*):

CALL TIME 3:00pm @ Synetic Theater Lobby

- White fold-over socks without embellishments, ballet slippers
- Hair in a high ballet bun
- *No makeup please.*

Level 1 Ballet Students (*Butterflies/Mice*):

CALL TIME 12:00pm @ Synetic Theater Lobby

- Studio Ice Blue Uniform Leotard, Pink /Nude tights with matching ballet slippers
- Hair in a high ballet bun
- *All Dancers may wear OPTIONAL Mascara*

Level 2 Ballet Students (*Jellyfish/Birds*):

CALL TIME 12:00pm @ Synetic Theater Lobby

- Studio Ice Blue Uniform Leotard, Pink /Nude tights with matching ballet slippers
- Hair in a high ballet bun
- *All Dancers may wear OPTIONAL Mascara*

Level 3 Ballet Students (*Jellyfish/Deer/Elephants*):

CALL TIME 12:00pm @ Synetic Theater Lobby

- Studio Ice Blue Uniform Leotard
- Pink/Nude tights with matching ballet slippers
- Nude under-camisole leotard for under costumes (*required*)
- Hair in high ballet bun
- Make-up: Neutral Stage eyeshadow, Brow Pencil, Black Mascara

Level 4 Ballet Students and Adults (*Random Animals/Duck/Elephants*):

CALL TIME 12:00pm @ Synetic Theater Lobby

- Nude under-camisole leotard to be worn under costume for Quick Changes back stage
- Pink/Nude tights with matching ballet slippers, all accessories for feet and pointe work
- Hair in a high ballet bun
- Make-up: Neutral Stage eyeshadow, Brow Pencil, Black Mascara, *False Lashes optional*

Level 5 Ballet Students (*Random Animals/Duck/Swan/Lion/Monkeys*):

CALL TIME 12:00pm @ Synetic Theater Lobby

- Nude under-camisole leotard to be worn for Quick Changes back stage
- Pink/Nude tights with matching ballet slippers and pointe shoes,
- Hair in a classic high pancake bun
- Make-up: Neutral Stage eyeshadow, Brow Pencil, Black Mascara, and False Lashes

Adult Ballet Students (*Grandparents/Turtle/Elephant*):

CALL TIME 12:00pm @ Synetic Theater Lobby

- Nude under-camisole leotard to be worn for Quick Changes back stage if necessary
- Pink/Nude tights with matching ballet slippers
- Hair in a classic high pancake bun
- Make-up: Neutral Stage eyeshadow, Brow Pencil, Black Mascara, and False Lashes

****FOR DANCERS THAT ELECT TO DANCE WITHOUT MASK:**

(it is recommended that unvaccinated dancers wear a mask, but not required)

- Make-up for faces: Foundation/Powder, Neutral Blush with contour, Med-Dark Rose Lipstick

- Because we are allowed onstage without masks, but must wear them outside of the backstage area, please consider this when selecting your lipstick. Long wearing lipsticks such as CoverGirl Outlast and Maybelline 24hr Wear will have less smudging/transfer when replacing masks
- Additional disposable masks will be available for dancers backstage
